

Options to Complete Courses

Assessed Grades & Attestations: An assessed grade is a final grade based on work completed comprising a defined proportion of the assignments in a course syllabus. Students may choose this option on their own. Assessed Grade Attestations (**available April 30, 2018**) are available to students who have requested an Assessed Grade. The Attestation form will be based on students' own confirmation of work done in the course, subject to review by their program or Faculty once the strike ends and grades are submitted that verify their results.

Dropping a Course Without Receiving a Grade: The last day to drop a full year Fall 2017/Winter2018 (Y) or Winter 2018 (W) term course without any penalty or notation on the student's transcript is **December 31, 2018**.

Tuition Credit Opportunity: Starting on Monday, April 30, the University will be offering a Tuition Credit Opportunity (TCO) to any student who withdraws from a full year Fall 2017/Winter 2018 (Y) or Winter 2018 (W) course. The TCO will allow students to retake the course(s) they have dropped, or another course, anytime before the end of the 2019 winter term, without paying additional tuition.

Pass/Fail Grading: Senate policy allows students to elect to earn a limited number of credits on a pass/fail basis in some courses. Senate has approved a broadening of the total number of credits and range of courses that can be taken on a Pass/Fail basis. The deadline to select this option was extended to the last day of classes on the original schedule for courses that continued or the revised schedule following the disruption.
